Public Hearing

- HB 2092 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Creates tax credit for contributions to Zero-Emission Incentive Fund.
- HB 3225
Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt rules applying certain oil spill prevention and emergency response planning requirements to railroads that own or operate high hazard train routes in this state.
- HB 2241
Requires Department of Environmental Quality to carry out study and propose recommendations for single, coordinated process for parties to meet certain federal and state requirements for, and to obtain certain releases from liability for, cleanup of hazardous waste.
- HB 2717 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Provides credit against income taxes for taxpayer creating jobs for certain removal and remedial actions.

Work Session

- HB 3257
Extends sunset on collection of certain moneys from electric companies or Oregon Community Power for purposes related to low-income electric bill payment assistance.
