#### Public Hearing

- HB 2026  
Permits pharmacist to substitute interchangeable biosimilar products for certain prescribed biological products.
- HB 2028  
Permits pharmacists to engage in practice of clinical pharmacy and provide patient care services to patients.
- HB 2951  
Requires policies and certificates of health insurance that offer prescription drug coverage to meet specified cost-sharing requirements.
- HB 3486  
Requires manufacturer of prescription drug with annual wholesale acquisition cost of \$10,000 or more, or with wholesale acquisition cost of \$10,000 or more per course of treatment, to file annual report with Oregon Health Authority on costs associated with prescription drug for previous calendar year.

#### Work Session

- HB 2600  
Requires continuation of group health insurance coverage for employee on family leave on same terms as when employee is not on leave.
- HB 2931  
Directs Oregon Health Authority to disseminate to school districts information related to elevated levels of radon.
- HB 2541  
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/13/15 AGENDA: Requires physician, physician assistant or individual licensed to practice nursing, in specified numbers, to be present at blood drives.
