HB 2875

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/3/15 AGENDA: Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to conduct study on effectiveness of laws establishing processes and procedures for pharmacy benefit managers.

HB 3178

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/3/15 AGENDA: Modifies requirements for pharmacy benefit managers with respect to maximum allowable cost lists.

HB 3200

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/3/15 AGENDA: Prohibits health care providers and health insurers from denying patient health care or reimbursement of costs of health care necessary to prevent death based on advanced age.

Requires State Board of Pharmacy to notify person subject to investigation for violation of proposed disciplinary action, to advise person to retain counsel and to impose penalties commensurate with offense.

HB 3376

Expands cost-sharing program for primary care internships and residencies.

HB 3378

Requires hospital to adopt written discharge policies.

HB 2605

Requires insurers to submit rate filings to Department of Consumer and Business Services no later than eight months prior to beginning of open enrollment period for health insurance exchange.

HB 2796

Establishes Board of Music Therapy within Health Licensing Office.
