#### Work Session

SB 231 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/15 AGENDA: Requires certain carriers, Public Employees' Benefit Board and Oregon Educators Benefit Board to report to Department of Consumer and Business Services proportion of carrier's and board's total medical expenses allocated to primary care.

SB 283

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/15 AGENDA: Prohibits individual from using title "Advanced Practice Registered Nurse" or abbreviation "APRN" unless individual is clinical nurse specialist, nurse practitioner or certified registered nurse anesthetist.

SB 298 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/15 AGENDA: Excludes high-velocity, short-amplitude manipulative thrusting from definition of "massage."

Excludes community colleges and accredited colleges and universities from definition of "massage facility."  
Increases number of class hours required for licensure as massage therapist or bodyworker.

SB 430

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/15 AGENDA: Authorizes State Board of Psychologist Examiners to withhold license to practice from applicant who has been convicted of sex crime.

SB 505

Requires, from October 1 through March 1 of each year, each hospital in this state to make offer to each patient of hospital who is 65 years of age or older to immunize patient against influenza virus.

SB 523 A

Requires insurer to provide specified notifications to health care providers regarding coverage under qualified health plan offered by insurer through health insurance exchange.

SB 684

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/15 AGENDA: Permits Oregon Medical Board to issue limited license to practice medicine to physician licensed in another state or country who holds full-time professor appointment at school of medicine in this state.

- SB 705 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/15 AGENDA: Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt rules requiring contractor to perform asbestos survey for purpose of determining whether residence or residential building is insulated with asbestos prior to demolition of residence or residential building.
- SB 833  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/15 AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Authority to give coordinated care organization at least 30 days' advance notice of proposed amendments to contracts.
- SB 874 A  
Requires Oregon Health Authority to disseminate information to health care professionals and public related to adrenal insufficiency.
- SB 901 A  
Requires insurer to reimburse providers directly for medical, surgical and nursing services provided to insured.
