SB 231 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Requires certain carriers, Public Employees' Benefit Board and Oregon Educators Benefit Board to report to Department of Consumer and Business Services proportion of carrier's and board's total medical expenses allocated to primary care.

SB 233

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Requires Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority to suspend, instead of terminate, medical assistance for person who is expected to remain in correctional facility for more than 12 months.

SB 833

CARRIED OVER FROM 6/1/15 AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Authority to give coordinated care organization at least 30 days' advance notice of proposed amendments to contracts.
