HB 2752 **

Increases maximum amount of corporate excise tax credit allowed for qualified research activities.

- HB 2434 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Rural Communities, Land Use, and Water then to Ways and Means Directs Oregon Business Development Department to establish and administer Natural Resource Transformative Technology Grant Program for purpose of providing grants to assist Oregon's businesses and research institutions to invest in and commercialize transformative natural resource technologies in this state.
