Public Hearing

HB 2670

Allows in-state tuition in certain circumstances for individuals who resided in Oregon but relocated due to position in military, government or humanitarian aid organization.

HB 2516

Requires community colleges and public universities to include cost of required course materials as part of tuition and mandatory fees.

HB 2747 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Increases limitation on subtraction for contribution to college savings network account to amount per designated beneficiary.

HB 2513

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to develop, maintain and manage book buying consortium to purchase academic course materials.
