Work Session

- HB 2288
Directs Oregon Innovation Council to submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than July 1, 2016, regarding distribution of moneys in Oregon Innovation Fund.
- HB 2871
Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to evaluate methods to improve effectiveness of public education at university level.
- HB 2832
Requires public university or community college that contracts with financial institution, organization or other institution for student financial aid services to make contract publicly available.
- HB 3075
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/15/15 AGENDA: Directs Department of Education to evaluate methods to improve delivery of career and technical education.
- HB 2611
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/15/15 AGENDA: Extends by six years period universities with institutional governing boards must participate in mandated shared services under same terms, conditions, funding, model and policy frameworks as existed in 2013.
- HB 2262
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/15/15 AGENDA: Directs Oregon Business Development Department to submit report to interim legislative committees regarding innovation in economic development no later than July 1, 2016.
- HB 2860 **
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/15/15 AGENDA: Establishes task force to study workforce development in Oregon and to make recommendations for legislation to improve workforce development in this state.
