HB 3342 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue Allows personal income taxpayers to subtract certain amounts paid as interest on qualified education loans from taxable income, subject to same income limitations applicable to federal education loan interest deduction. HB 3390 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Directs Department of Corrections to enter into interagency agreement with community college and public university for purpose of establishing program that provides post-secondary education to inmates.

HB 2616 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes State Apprenticeship Education and Training Fund and continuously appropriates moneys in fund to State Apprenticeship and Training Council and Bureau of Labor and Industries for specified purposes.
