HB 2015 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Human Services, in consultation with Early Learning Division and Office of Child Care, to adopt rules for subsidy programs for employment-related child care that, at minimum, provide for one year of eligibility regardless of change in employment, permit students enrolled in coursework and self-employed persons to receive subsidized employment-related child care, and provide for reduced copayments and incentive payments when child care provider meets specified minimum stand

For the Purpose of re-referral to House Committee and Judiciary:

HB 2392 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Department of Human Services to issue specified types of public assistance through electronic benefits transfer card.

HB 2393
Requires Oregon State Lottery to hold lottery prize in excess of \$600 that is owed to person that has not repaid overpayment of public assistance or medical assistance benefits.

HB 2394
Requires Director of Oregon State Lottery to provide information about lottery prize recipient to Department of Human Services within seven days after paying lottery prize of \$1,000 or more.
