#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3524

Requires state, when selling or disposing of real property, to grant right of first refusal to developers of affordable housing.

#### Work Session

HB 2195

Directs county to use proceeds acquired by foreclosure of delinquent tax liens or in exchange for land originally acquired by foreclosure of delinquent tax liens to provide low income housing, social services or child care services.

HB 2233

Requires Oregon Health Authority to continue to reimburse behavioral rehabilitation services provider for children removed pending investigation of abuse.

HB 2360

Requires Department of Human Services to notify school district, Teacher Standards and Practices Commission and Department of Education of report of alleged child abuse occurring at school.

HB 2547

Requires housing with services facility to register with Housing and Community Services Department.

HB 2756

Requires licensing agency to adopt rules to ensure that caregivers in licensed residential facilities and adult foster homes have practical knowledge and skills necessary to maintain health, safety and welfare of residents.

HB 3391 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Requires Attorney General to file action on behalf of Department of Human Services employee for stalking citation or stalking protective order upon request and upon substantiation of facts and evidence of repeated and unwanted contact causing alarm or coercion to employee.
