HB 2327

Modifies statutes relating to custodianship of practice of nonperforming attorney.

HB 2328

Clarifies that party that is not natural person must appear in court proceedings by attorney unless otherwise specifically provided by law.

HB 2333

Clarifies that certain statutes of limitation are tolled if person entitled to bring action is child or is insane.

HB 2335

Revises definition of "enter or remain unlawfully" for purposes of crimes of burglary and criminal trespass.

HB 2336

Allows filing and service of notice of appeal by mailing for delivery within three calendar days via United States Postal Service or commercial delivery service.
