Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2372

Requires that police officer be certified by Department of Public Safety Standards and Training rather than Board on Public Safety Standards and Training before officer may request urine test of person arrested for offense of driving while under influence of intoxicants.

HB 2380

Authorizes court in post-conviction relief proceeding, upon joint motion of parties, to vacate judgment or order and remand proceeding to circuit court to reconsider judgment or order.

HB 2381

Allows prosecuting attorney 90 days after entry of judgment of disposition for youth offender to present restitution information to court.
