Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing

HB 2324

Authorizes participant in peer support counseling session to waive confidentiality of communications made or information conveyed by participant in session.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2609

Provides that information or complaint may be verified by complainant's certifying sufficient grounds to believe defendant committed offense.

HB 2761

Requires Department of Corrections to withhold portion of inmate's retained compensation in manner of wage garnishment if department receives notice of judgment including money award entered against inmate for assault or battery of department employee.

HB 2225

Authorizes circuit court judge to authorize execution of search warrant outside judicial district of court in certain elder abuse cases.
