Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3014

Changes definition of "grandparent" in laws pertaining to notice to grandparents of juvenile dependency hearings regarding grandchildren, and that authorize grandparents to request visitation or other contact or communication with grandchildren when grandchildren are in legal custody of Department of Human Services.

Work Session

HB 2340

Limits personal information that may be included in certain judgments, orders and other court documents.

HB 2358 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Judicial Department, Public Defense Services Commission, Department of Human Services and Department of Justice to collaborate to establish pilot programs in four to six Oregon counties to reduce foster care use through effective representation in juvenile dependency proceedings.

HB 2361 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Prohibits court from charging or collecting fee for filing of objections or motions by office of Long Term Care Ombudsman or specified system when office or system has been given notice in protective proceeding.

HB 2362

Requires court to give greatest consideration to benefit to person who is subject of protective proceeding by party's actions in proceeding when determining whether to award attorney fees.

HB 2908

Brings Oregon law into compliance with federal Preventing Sex Trafficking and Strengthening Families Act of 2014.
