Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2349

Requires petition for appointment of professional fiduciary to include information regarding investment credentials, licensing, compensation and method for assessing or charging compensation.

HB 2371

Provides that evidence of test administered, or observation made, by police officer as part of drug recognition evaluation is admissible in judicial or administrative proceeding if certain conditions are met.

HB 2628

Disallows all filing fees, service fees and hearing fees in action for court's protective stalking order, even if stalking order is not only relief sought in action.

HB 2806

Provides that Department of Public Safety Standards and Training may not deny, suspend or revoke certification of corrections officer because corrections officer seeks help with mental health issues, substance abuse or other counseling needs.

HB 2915 **

Establishes credit against personal income taxes for purchase of qualifying gun safes.
