#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2423

Provides that inmates convicted of certain crimes are not eligible for earned time reduction in prison sentence.

HB 2660

Provides court discretion to order person participating in driving while under influence of intoxicants diversion agreement to install ignition interlock device if person submitted to chemical test of person's breath or blood and test disclosed blood alcohol content below 0.10 percent by weight.

HB 2704

Provides that recording of peace officer or parole and probation officer does not constitute crime of interfering with peace officer or parole and probation officer unless recording actually prevents officer from performing lawful duties.

HB 2609

Provides that information or complaint may be verified by complainant's certifying sufficient grounds to believe defendant committed offense.

#### Work Session

HB 2357

Modifies certain law enforcement defenses applicable to certain firearms-related crimes.

HB 2385

Provides that person commits crime of luring a minor if offense involves police officer posing as minor.
