Public Hearing

HB 2367 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on Adopting the Uniform Collateral Consequences of Conviction Act.

Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2329 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Modifies biennial distribution to Legal Aid Account from amounts collected as fees and charges in circuit courts.

SB 342
Makes nonsubstantive and technical changes in Oregon law.

Work Session

HB 2326
Provides that when conditional discharge probation has expired but defendant has not fulfilled terms and conditions, case shall not be dismissed.

HB 2356
Increases penalty for crime of invasion of personal privacy if defendant has certain prior convictions or person recorded is under 18 years of age.

HB 2382
Authorizes court to determine fitness to proceed in probation violation proceedings.

HB 2420
Provides that criminal defendant found unfit to proceed shall be interviewed to determine availability of treatment in community prior to decision on commitment if defendant's most serious charge is Class C felony or misdemeanor.

HB 2596
Provides that person who records another person's intimate areas commits crime of invasion of personal privacy.

HB 3436
Requires that State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision have five members.
