HB 2320

Decreases penalty for crime of cheating to maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both. *For the purpose of consideration of amendments.* 

## **Work Session**

HB 2429

Repeals sunset on provisions related to relief from prohibition on possessing and purchasing firearms.

HB 2423

Provides that inmates convicted of certain crimes are not eligible for earned time reduction in prison sentence.

HB 2902

Eliminates automatic reporting of person found to have committed act that would constitute felony sex crime if committed by adult.

HB 3206

Permits any person convicted of offense with relevant DNA evidence to file motion for DNA testing.
