Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3437

Establishes procedures for applying for Certificate of Good Standing eligibility certification and petitioning for and issuance of Certificate of Good Standing.

HB 3168

Authorizes court to waive previously imposed criminal fine if defendant demonstrates completion of drug treatment program.

HB 3365

Modifies crime of displaying obscene materials to minors.

Public Hearing

HB 3249

Authorizes court to initiate civil commitment proceedings if person is unable or refuses to comply with order of assisted outpatient treatment.

HB 2907

Establishes definition of "recidivism" for purposes of tracking and compiling data regarding recidivism of youth and youth offenders.

Work Session

HB 3206

Permits any person convicted of offense with relevant DNA evidence to file motion for DNA testing.
