#### Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 199 A

Requires State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision to notify victim, if requested, prior to hearing or administrative decision to reset or advance release date of prisoner for outstanding reformation, severe medical condition or age-related incapacity.

SB 350 A

Modifies provisions relating to motions for change of judge.

SB 377 A

Modifies crime of computer crime.

SB 825 A

Provides that defendant has right to appear as witness before grand jury in certain circumstances.

SB 839 A

Exempts specified persons from arrest and prosecution for certain offenses and for certain violations of terms of release or supervision if evidence of offense was obtained because emergency medical services or law enforcement agency was contacted to obtain necessary medical assistance due to drug-related overdose.
