Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

HB 2456

Modifies optional process for evaluation of changes to urban growth boundary of city outside Metro with population of 10,000 or more.

HB 2457

Allows county to create parcel that is smaller than minimum size standard in resource zone for farm or forest use when part of existing unit of land has been included within urban growth boundary to be planned and zoned for urbanization.

HB 2633

Requires Land Conservation and Development Commission to adopt administrative rules to implement statewide land use planning goal related to natural hazards.

Public Hearing

HB 2435

Directs Oregon Business Development Department and Oregon Infrastructure Finance Authority to establish Oregon Infrastructure Opportunity Program to provide loans, including forgivable loans, for rural infrastructure projects.

HB 2436

Permits Oregon Infrastructure Finance Authority to provide financial assistance for levee projects that contribute to improvement, expansion or repair of infrastructure systems and are essential for use or development of farm, industrial or commercial land. 2734 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Transportation and Economic Development

HB 2734 **

Authorizes city or county to organize land bank authority by act of incorporation adopted by special ordinance.
