Public Hearing

HB 3028

Directs Oregon Broadband Advisory Council, in consultation with local businesses in rural areas of state, to prepare report regarding broadband technology and access in rural areas of state.

HB 3030

Authorizes creation of sand control districts for purpose of controlling drifting sand.

HB 2720

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/5/2015 AGENDA: Requires that, in election proposing annexation, votes from city and territory to be annexed be counted separately to determine separate majorities if territory to be annexed includes 100 acres or more.

HB 2938

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/5/2015 AGENDA: Prohibits city from requiring consent to annexation of landowner's property in exchange for city providing county service as agent of county.

Work Session

HB 2734 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Transportation and Economic Development

Authorizes city or county to organize land bank authority by act of incorporation adopted by special ordinance.

HB 2579

Authorizes domestic water supply district to contract to provide services to cooperative corporation that supplies water for domestic purposes.

HB 2400

Provides that submission of certain task force reports prior to January 31, 2015, satisfies requirement to submit reports by July 1, 2014.
