Public Hearing

HB 3217

Requires Department of State Lands to adopt pilot program for providing general authorization for voluntary stream restoration and beaver recovery through construction of artificial beaver dams.

HB 2723

Authorizes county or city to designate any urbanized area of county or city as urban agriculture incentive zone.

HB 3224

Modifies review process for post-acknowledgment land use decisions of city outside Metro that uses simplified method for amending urban growth boundary.

HB 3444

Requires United States to extinguish title to public lands and transfer title to public lands to state on or before December 13, 2018.

HJM 13

Urges President and Congress to transfer title of certain federal public lands to State of Oregon.

HB 3457 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Creates income tax credit for investment in business that hires employees in rural area.

HB 3240 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Task Force on the Transfer of Federal Land Ownership in Oregon.

Work Session

HB 2652 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Amends definition of "rural area" to mean area outside urban growth boundary of city of 40,000 or more, as boundary is acknowledged on date on which application is submitted for strategic investment program.
