HB 3444

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/31/15 AGENDA: Requires United States to extinguish title to public lands and transfer title to public lands to state on or before December 13, 2018.

HJM 13

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/31/15 AGENDA: Urges President and Congress to transfer title of certain federal public lands to State of Oregon.

HB 3240 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/31/15 AGENDA: Establishes Task Force on the Transfer of Federal Land Ownership in Oregon.

HB 3457 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/31/15 AGENDA: Creates income tax credit for investment in business that hires employees in rural area.

HB 2723

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/31/15 AGENDA: Authorizes county or city to designate any urbanized area of county or city as urban agriculture incentive zone.

HB 2434 A**

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Oregon Business Development Department to establish and administer Natural Resource Transformative Technology Grant Program for purpose of providing grants to assist Oregon's businesses and research institutions to invest in and commercialize transformative natural resource technologies in this state.

HB 3221

Modifies process for determining need for buildable land to meet estimated need for housing.

Work Session

HB 3274

Directs Oregon Business Development Department to conduct study and submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than December 31, 2016, regarding methods to expand technology infrastructure in rural cities and counties in Oregon.

HB 3169

Directs Water Resources Department to conduct study to determine certain information regarding aquifers in this state.

HB 2830

Modifies time period for local government to take action on application for permit, limited land use decision or zone change after remand based on final order of Land Use Board of Appeals.

HB 2038

Modifies definition of "recreational purposes" for purpose of limiting liability of owners of land that allow public use of land for recreational activity, including aviation activity.
