#### Work Session

- SB 206 A  
Allows temporary lease or temporary transfer of upper Klamath Basin water right established by Water Resources Director in order of determination during period while judicial review of order is pending.
- SB 264 A  
Authorizes Water Resources Department to participate in activities related to joint management entity for carrying out Upper Klamath Basin Comprehensive Agreement.
- SB 320 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/21/15 AGENDA: -Allows food establishment located within residential dwelling to produce limited amounts of certain foods for sale to public without being regulated by State Department of Agriculture.
- SB 534  
Authorizes city and airport to enter into agreement pursuant to which city provides sewer and water services to airport without requiring annexation, or consent to eventual annexation, to city of territory on which airport is situated.
- SB 953  
Establishes process by which future interests in specified properties in Klamath County may be extinguished.
- SB 958  
Creates free license for organizers of certain fishing derbies to take and sell fish taken during duration of derby.
