- HB 3314  
Establishes Joint Legislative Committee on Beacon Provisions Review to monitor, investigate and evaluate effectiveness of major laws.
- HJM 20  
Urges Congress to fund and maintain United States Coast Guard Air Facility at Newport, Oregon, in perpetuity.

#### Work Session

- HB 3475  
Enacts Interstate Compact for Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by National Popular Vote.
- HB 3483  
Adds secular organizations and parties to marriage to list of persons and entities authorized to solemnize marriages.
- HB 3510  
Requires legislative measures to contain brief and impartial statement of problem measure is intended to solve.
- HJR 31  
Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to vest power of impeachment of statewide elected Executive Branch officials in House of Representatives and power to try impeachments in Senate.
- HB 2995  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/8: Requires transportation network company to maintain insurance policy to cover private passenger motor vehicle when vehicle's registered owner or designated operator actively participates as driver with transportation network company.
- HB 3300  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/8: Requires primary care physician to serve specified percentage of medical assistance recipients in order to contract with Public Employees' Benefit Board or Oregon Educators Benefit Board to provide medical care.
