### Work Session

HB 2198 A

Directs Housing and Community Services Department to develop and implement Affordable Family Housing Development Program to expand state's supply of affordable housing for families with children and incomes below 60 percent of area median income.

HB 2730

Requires Department of Transportation to study development of uniform speed bump height and markings. HB 2995

Requires transportation network company to maintain insurance policy to cover private passenger motor vehicle when vehicle's registered owner or designated operator actively participates as driver with transportation network company.

HB 3225

Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt rules applying certain oil spill prevention and emergency response planning requirements to railroads that own or operate high hazard train routes in this state.

HB 3300

Requires primary care physician to serve specified percentage of medical assistance recipients in order to contract with Public Employees' Benefit Board or Oregon Educators Benefit Board to provide medical care.

HB 3470 A

Requires Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule statewide greenhouse gas emissions limits for years 2020 and 2050 and to adopt interim statewide greenhouse gas emissions limits consistent with 2050 limit every five years.
