#### Work Session

- HB 2478  
Makes statutory changes to achieve gender neutral language with respect to legally recognized marriages.
- HB 2736  
Requires Department of Transportation to study development of uniform speed bump height and markings.
- HB 2879 \*\*  
Establishes task force to study financing and delivery of health care in this state and make recommendations regarding legislative changes to ensure that residents of this state have access to high-quality health care. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2936 A  
Defines "sobering facility." Extends civil and criminal immunity to sobering facilities for actions taken in good faith, on probable cause and without malice.
- HB 3500  
Provides primary ballot of all major parties to nonaffiliated electors.
- HJM 16  
Urges Congress to work with Turkish diplomats, European Union and NATO allies to stop mass arrests and detainment of journalists in Turkey.
- HB 2198 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/18: Directs Housing and Community Services Department to develop and implement Affordable Family Housing Development Program to expand state's supply of affordable housing for families with children and incomes below 60 percent of area median income.
- HB 2730  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/18: Requires Department of Transportation to study development of uniform speed bump height and markings.
- HB 3225  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/18: Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt rules applying certain oil spill prevention and emergency response planning requirements to railroads that own or operate high hazard train routes in this state.

HB 3470 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/18: Requires Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule statewide greenhouse gas emissions limits for years 2020 and 2050 and to adopt interim statewide greenhouse gas emissions limits consistent with 2050 limit every five years.
