HB 3549

Requires State Forestry Department to collect and analyze information regarding sufficiency of existing legal requirements to protect certain areas in proximity to forestland from impacts due to application of pesticides by aircraft.

HB 2478

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/20: Makes statutory changes to achieve gender neutral language with respect to legally recognized marriages.

HB 2879 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/20: Establishes task force to study financing and delivery of health care in this state and make recommendations regarding legislative changes to ensure that residents of this state have access to high-quality health care.

HB 2936 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/20: Defines "sobering facility." Extends civil and criminal immunity to sobering facilities for actions taken in good faith, on probable cause and without malice.

HB 3470 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/20: Requires Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule statewide greenhouse gas emissions limits for years 2020 and 2050 and to adopt interim statewide greenhouse gas emissions limits consistent with 2050 limit every five years.

HB 3500

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/20: Provides primary ballot of all major parties to nonaffiliated electors.
