### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

HB 3557

Requires public bodies that receive requests for disclosure of specified personal contact information of public employees or certain other persons to forward copy of request to affected persons whose information is subject of request or their representatives.

#### **Work Session**

HB 2020

Alters definition of "public official."

Prohibits Governor, First Partner, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, Attorney General and Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries from receiving money or other consideration for speaking engagement or presentation.

HB 2178

Requires campaign finance statement to be filed within two business days if aggregate amount of contributions equaling or exceeding \$2,500 from single donor is received during 14-day period immediately preceding election.

SB 9

Directs Secretary of State to conduct performance audit of state agency public records retention and disclosure practices, including analysis and recommendations on specified criteria.

HB 2668 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27: Requires minimum buffer zone between areas zoned for cultivation of industrial hemp and marijuana grow sites.

HB 2936 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27: Defines "sobering facility." Extends civil and criminal immunity to sobering facilities for actions taken in good faith, on probable cause and without malice.

HB 3470 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27: Requires Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule statewide greenhouse gas emissions limits for years 2020 and 2050 and to adopt interim statewide greenhouse gas emissions limits consistent with 2050 limit every five years.

HB 3549

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27: Requires State Forestry Department to collect and analyze information regarding sufficiency of existing legal requirements to protect certain areas in proximity to forestland from impacts due to application of pesticides by aircraft.
