- HCR 32
In memoriam: Edward J. Whelan, 1926-2015.
- SB 458
Designates February 14 of each year as Oregon Statehood Day.
- SCR 2
In memoriam: Lenhart "Bud" Gienger, 1935-2014.
- SCR 3
Recognizes contributions and sacrifices of Peace Corps volunteers from Oregon and throughout United States.
- SCR 9

- SCR 11

Work Session

- HB 2178
Requires campaign finance statement to be filed within two business days if aggregate amount of contributions equaling or exceeding \$2,500 from single donor is received during 14-day period immediately preceding election.
- HB 2274
Changes name of Multimodal Transportation Fund to Connect Oregon Fund.
- HB 2668 A
Requires minimum buffer zone between areas zoned for cultivation of industrial hemp and marijuana grow sites.

AGENDA (Cont.)
June 3, 2015

- HB 2936 A
Defines "sobering facility." Extends civil and criminal immunity to sobering facilities for actions taken in good faith, on probable cause and without malice.
- HB 3549
Requires State Forestry Department to collect and analyze information regarding sufficiency of existing legal requirements to protect certain areas in proximity to forestland from impacts due to application of pesticides by aircraft.
- SB 29
Establishes procedures for electing precinct committee persons.
