- HB 2259  
Modifies authority of Department of Transportation to issue variance permits to operate self-loading log truck.
- HB 2639 \*\*  
Funds free transit passes for secondary school students residing in service area of Lane Transit District. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2837  
Directs Director of Transportation to issue certificate of exemption from requirement to use child safety system, safety belt or safety harness if statement is submitted by nurse practitioner or physician assistant on behalf of person requesting exemption.
- HB 2979  
Funds free, or reduced-fare, transit passes for students attending public secondary schools and increased transit service in vicinity of public secondary schools.
- HJM 5  
Urges Congress to reauthorize Build America Bonds program to allow states and local governments to finance infrastructure in most efficient manner.

- HB 2658
