Requires Director of Oregon Health Authority to notify Director of Veterans' Affairs upon receipt of certain written information from member or veteran of uniformed service, if authorized to do so by member or veteran.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Provides that U.S. Highway 395 shall be known as World War I Veterans Memorial Highway.HB2645 ****Subsequent Referral(s) to Higher Education, Innovation, and Workforce Development

Requires community colleges and public universities to establish priority enrollment system for qualified students who are active members of Armed Forces of the United States or qualified veterans.

HB 2763

Removes provision that public officer or employee who leaves position to perform military duty may not, while performing military duty, receive amount of pay entitled to before leave of absence.

HB 2108 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits Extends sunset for tax credit for provision of medical care to residents of Oregon Veterans' Home.
