HB 2210

Authorizes individuals acting under authority of broadcasters to enter geographic area subject to declaration of emergency to report news or public safety information or to maintain essential broadcast equipment.

Work Session

HB 2763

Removes provision that public officer or employee who leaves position to perform military duty may not, while performing military duty, receive amount of pay entitled to before leave of absence.

HB 2108 **

Extends sunset for tax credit for provision of medical care to residents of Oregon Veterans' Home. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
