HB 2269 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Creates office of State Resilience Officer in Oregon Department of Administrative Services to direct, coordinate and oversee seismic safety and resilience planning and preparation by state agencies.

HB 2270 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Creates office of State Resilience Officer in office of Governor to direct, coordinate and oversee seismic safety and resilience planning and preparation by state agencies.

Possible Work Session

HB 2210

Authorizes individuals acting under authority of broadcasters to enter geographic area subject to declaration of emergency to report news or public safety information or to maintain essential broadcast equipment.

HB 2539

Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to submit report related to delivery and usage of medical services by women veterans to interim legislative committees no later than July 1, 2016.

HB 2230

Requires Director of Oregon Health Authority to notify Director of Veterans' Affairs upon receipt of certain written information from member or veteran of uniformed service, if authorized to do so by member or veteran.
