- HB 2839 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue
Allows credit against income taxes for employment of qualified military veterans.
- HB 2892
Requires that National League of Families' POW/MIA flag be displayed with Oregon State flag on public buildings in this state.

Possible Work Session

- HB 2270 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Creates office of State Resilience Officer in office of Governor to direct, coordinate and oversee seismic safety and resilience planning and preparation by state agencies.
- HB 2838 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Oregon Incarcerated Veterans Outreach Program in Department of Veterans' Affairs to conduct outreach and provide assistance to incarcerated veterans and spouses and dependents of incarcerated veterans.
