- SB 45 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
Extends sunset for tax credit for qualified equity investment.
- SB 52
Extends sunset of corporate tax offset of insurer assessment.
- SB 117
Establishes Task Force on Jurisdictional Transfers.
- SB 715
Permits travel retailers that are not licensed insurance producers to offer travel insurance at direction of licensed insurance producers, subject to certain restrictions.
- SB 801 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
Creates credit against income tax for taxpayers that create 10 or more new jobs during tax year.
- SB 441 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes Trust for Cultural Development Board to solicit and accept gifts, bequests or devises of money, securities or other property.
