**Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits SB 45 ** Extends sunset for tax credit for qualified equity investment. SB 52 Extends sunset of corporate tax offset of insurer assessment. SB 117 Establishes Task Force on Jurisdictional Transfers. SB 715 Permits travel retailers that are not licensed insurance producers to offer travel insurance at direction of licensed insurance producers, subject to certain restrictions. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits SB 801 ** Creates credit against income tax for taxpayers that create 10 or more new jobs during tax year. SB - 33 Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for State Fair Council, for conducting Oregon State Fair, carrying out state fairground business operations or operating state fairground properties and facilities. SB 34 Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for State Fair Council, for repair, maintenance or insurance of state fairground properties or capital expenditures for buildings or equipment. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means SB 441 **

Authorizes Trust for Cultural Development Board to solicit and accept gifts, bequests or devises of money, securities or other property.
