Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 685
Deregulates oversight of for-hire carriers of persons.
- SB 142
Subjects vehicles owned or operated by transportation districts to laws regulating motor carriers.
- SB 455
Deregulates oversight of for-hire carriers of persons.
- SB 275
Requires mortgage loan servicers to obtain license or endorsement and requires other persons that engage in business as mortgage loan servicers to obtain endorsement.
- SB 276
Applies licensing requirements and other obligations on buy-here-pay-here lenders that are similar to requirements to which payday lenders and title lenders are subject.
- SB 278
Voids payday loan, title loan, or consumer finance loan of \$50,000 or less, if at time loan is made person making loan does not have required license.
- SB 182
Exempts certain for-hire carriers of household goods from economic regulation.
- SB 699
Broadens exemption to provisions regulating cosmetology disciplines for persons who prepare individual's hair solely for professional photograph or theatrical performance.
