Possible Reconsideration and Work Session

HB 2832 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/2015 AGENDA: Directs governing entity of public or private post-secondary institution of education that contracts with third party financial firm for student financial aid services to consider federal policies for contracting.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2469 A

Establishes requirements for certain insurers to conduct own risk and solvency assessment and to file report of assessment with Department of Consumer and Business Services.

HB 3318 A

Establishes Oregon State Lottery Responsible Gambling Code of Practice.

HB 3062

Exempts prepaid transportation cards from Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act and related statutes.

HB 2281 A

For purposes of per-mile road usage charge, makes issuance by Department of Transportation of emblem of exemption from motor vehicle fuel taxes permissive, removes exception to requirement that seller collect use fuel taxes on motor vehicle paying per-mile road usage charge and removes requirement that Department of Transportation round metered use of subject vehicle up to next whole mile.

HB 2465 A

Modifies requirements related to school enrollment that person under 18 years of age must meet before being issued driving privileges.

HB 2941 A

Authorizes electric company to offer residential electricity consumer rate option for electricity associated with specific energy resource.

HB 3414 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/2015 AGENDA: Requires certain persons to not drive in far left lane unless passing.

- HB 2567 A
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/2015 AGENDA: Allows direct purchase and sale of bulk distilled liquor between distillery licensees for blending and manufacturing purposes.
- HB 3056 A
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/2015 AGENDA: Specifies that crematorium may not be certified by State Mortuary and Cemetery Board if board determines that proposed crematorium presents danger to public health and safety as determined in consideration of standards for training and equipment used in practice of cremation that are based on national industry standards.
- HB 3317 A
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27/2015 AGENDA: Directs Oregon State Lottery Commission, in coordination with Oregon Liquor Control Commission, to submit report biennially on distribution and concentration of video lottery game terminals in relation to measures of socioeconomic status represented at census tract level of neighborhoods or communities in which premises of video lottery retailers are located.
