SB 84

CARRIED OVER FROM 2/24/2015 AGENDA: Establishes statewide standards and funding mechanisms for accelerated college credit programs for high school students.

SB 518

CARRIED OVER FROM 2/24/2015 AGENDA: Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to convene work group of representatives from public universities and community colleges to determine whether 40-40-20 mission would be enhanced by enabling universities to award associate degrees. 187 ** ** Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

SB 187 **

Establishes task force to make recommendations regarding protection of privacy of students using education software.

SB 519

Directs community college districts to use uniform budget and accounting system.

SB 473

Requires each public university, community college or other institution of higher education to allow students, faculty and staff to identify sexual orientation on forms used to collect demographic data.
