Work Session

- SB 44 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
Extends sunset for tax credit for university venture development fund contributions.
- SB 667
Removes sunset related to grants distributed to small school districts with one or more small high schools.
- SB 932
Extends eligibility for receiving Oregon financial aid scholarships and grants to certain students who qualify for exemption from paying nonresident tuition.
- SB 187 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes task force to make recommendations regarding protection of privacy of students using education software.

Public Hearing

- SB 759
Requires four-year post-secondary institutions that enroll students who receive Oregon Opportunity Grant to adopt written protocol to ensure that students who report sexual assault receive necessary services and assistance.
- SB 790
Requires Department of Justice to encourage and support services, programs and curricula to educate and inform students in grades 7 through 12 about domestic violence.
- SB 856
Establishes child sexual abuse prevention instructional program for public schools.
