### **Possible Introduction of Committee Measures**

#### Work Session SB 44 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits

- Extends sunset for tax credit for university venture development fund contributions.
- SB 667
  - Removes sunset related to grants distributed to small school districts with one or more small high schools.
- SB 932

Extends eligibility for receiving Oregon financial aid scholarships and grants to certain students who qualify for exemption from paying nonresident tuition.

SB 187 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes task force to make recommendations regarding protection of privacy of students using education software.

### **Public Hearing**

SB 759

Requires four-year post-secondary institutions that enroll students who receive Oregon Opportunity Grant to adopt written protocol to ensure that students who report sexual assault receive necessary services and assistance.

SB 790

Requires Department of Justice to encourage and support services, programs and curricula to educate and inform students in grades 7 through 12 about domestic violence.

SB 856

Establishes child sexual abuse prevention instructional program for public schools.
