SB 875

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/16/2015 AGENDA: Requires State Board of Education to adopt rules under which school personnel may administer medications that treat adrenal insufficiency to students experiencing adrenal crisis.

SB 895

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/16/2015 AGENDA: Requires schools and children's facilities to make available certain information related to immunizations.

SB 709

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/16/2015 AGENDA: Modifies provisions to allow students who are not residents of school district to attend school of school district.

SB 612

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/16/2015 AGENDA: Requires school districts to screen students for risk factors for dyslexia and to ensure specified staff members receive training related to dyslexia.

SJR 18

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/16/2015 AGENDA: Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution directing Legislative Assembly to establish education support fund consisting of revenues from sales tax imposed at rate not to exceed \_\_\_ percent.

SB 80

Clarifies that governing boards of universities with governing board are included in list of entities that must continue to provide and improve upon effective articulation and transfer framework for students in Oregon's post-secondary sectors.

SB 214

Makes calculation of aggregate days membership for kindergarten students contingent on early reading program.

- SB 215  
Removes sunset on Oregon Education Investment Board.
- SB 216  
Allows education service districts to receive funding from Department of Education to accomplish purposes of Network of Quality Teaching and Learning.
- SB 217  
Repeals statutory requirements related to specific strategic education investments.
- SB 493  
Removes ability of Governor to disband university governing board or force university to take other action if university fails to make timely compliance with conditions established when State Board of Higher Education endorsed governing board.
- SB 860  
Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to select University of Oregon or Oregon State University to design and develop career advising and mentorship pilot program.
- SB 953  
Establishes process by which future interests in specified properties in Klamath County may be extinguished.
- SB 957  
Prohibits State Board of Education from establishing certain standards for instructional time unless moneys available for state's system of kindergarten through grade 12 public education meet specified percentage of amount of moneys determined to be sufficient by Quality Education Commission.
