Possible Work Session

- SB 478
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/18/2015 AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish and maintain list of designated high priority chemicals of concern for children's health used in children's products and to periodically review and revise list.
- SB 20
Modifies applicability of minimum energy efficiency standards to certain products.
- SB 248
Authorizes State Forester to enter into and administer contracts for activities necessary or convenient for sales of timber from lands owned or managed by State Board of Forestry or State Forestry Department.
- SB 752
Conditionally exempts from regulation under certain air pollution laws carbon dioxide emissions from combustion or decomposition of biomass.

Public Hearing

- SB 206
Allows temporary lease or temporary transfer of upper Klamath Basin water right established by Water Resources Director in order of determination during period while judicial review of order is pending.
- SB 264
Authorizes Water Resources Director to participate in activities related to joint management entity for carrying out Upper Klamath Basin Comprehensive Agreement.
- SB 265 **
Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds to finance implementation of Klamath Basin Restoration Agreement of 2010. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
