#### Public Hearing

HB 3217 A

Requires Department of State Lands to adopt pilot program for providing general authorization for voluntary stream restoration and beaver recovery through construction of artificial beaver dams.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 3068 A

Directs Department of Environmental Quality to conduct study and develop recommendations for legislation to reduce woodstove smoke.

HB 3223 A

Modifies provisions authorizing expedited land divisions.

HB 3282 A

Provides that Land Conservation and Development Commission may permit cities to undergo periodic review for limited purpose of completing work relating to certain urban growth boundary amendments.

HJM 19

Urges Secretary of Energy and Congress to support siting of United States Department of Energy's Frontier Observatory for Research in Geothermal Energy at Newberry Geothermal Project.

HB 3329

Modifies standard by which geothermal energy qualifies as type of green energy technology for which at least 1.5 percent of total contract price of certain public improvement contract for construction or certain reconstruction or major renovation of public school building must be spent.
