Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2830 A
Modifies time period for local government to take action on application for permit, limited land use decision or zone change after remand based on final order of Land Use Board of Appeals.
- HB 2831
Modifies authority to use property line adjustments in resource zones.
- HB 3050
Modifies requirements for composition of boards of directors of regional air quality control authorities.
- HB 3214 A
Directs Land Conservation and Development Commission to adopt or amend rules related to statewide planning goals to allow local government to rezone land for certain purposes.
- HB 3478 A
Phases in prohibition on manufacture and sale of personal care products and over-the-counter drugs that contain synthetic plastic microbeads.

Possible Work Session

- HB 2034
Removes State Parks and Recreation Department's authorization to exercise power of eminent domain over certain land situated within boundaries of Willamette River Greenway.
- HB 2277 A
Modifies authority of drainage districts to perform flood control activity.
- HB 2463 A
Authorizes Department of State Lands to seize abandoned structures and derelict structures on, under or over state-owned submerged and submersible lands.
- HB 2509 A
Requires State Department of Agriculture to provide mediation program services when person has reasonable belief that planting, growing or harvesting of agricultural or horticultural commodity on nearby land might interfere or is interfering with farming practices.
