Public Hearing

SB 567

Requires interest on moneys in General Fund to be deposited into Oregon Rainy Day Fund.

SB 925

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to report to Legislative Assembly on options for tax reform and make recommendations for legislation intended to reform current tax system.

Work Session

SB 472 A

Increases maximum number of Pacific Wonderland registration plates that may be issued.

SB 924

Directs Department of Revenue to study issue of allowing certain homesteads of senior citizens that have appreciated by more than 50 percent to enter homestead property tax deferral program.

Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 864

Expands definition of "real property," for purposes of natural resource credit against estate tax, to include real property in neighboring states.
