Please Note Different Time **SB 663 A Carried Over from Tuesday 6/2/15 for Work Session**

Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2690 A

Exempts from property taxation land acquired and held by nonprofit corporation for building residences to be sold to individuals whose income is not greater than 80 percent of area median income.

HB 3492 A

Requires county, upon request of owner of solar project, to enter into agreement, for period not to exceed 20 years, pursuant to which property constituting solar project is exempt from property taxation and owner pays fee in lieu of taxes.

Work Session

SB 925

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to report to Legislative Assembly on options for tax reform and make recommendations for legislation intended to reform current tax system.

HB 3030

Authorizes creation of sand control districts for purpose of controlling drifting sand.

SB 415 A

Prohibits distributing, selling or allowing to be sold flavored tobacco products in this state.

SB 663 A

(Carried Over from 6/2/15 meeting) Requires premises where person makes retail sales of tobacco products and inhalant delivery systems to be licensed by Oregon Liquor Control Commission.
